## Curriculum

Our curriculum comes from a variety of publishers. Some of the common publishers used are A-Beka, Bob Jones, and ACSI. Students also utilize our online program, Hagerstown Area Virtual Christian Academy, for credits as well as remediation and enrichment.

## Bible Version

The KJV, NKJV, NASB, or NIV Bible are the primary translations used in the classroom for memory work and tests. Other translations may be used as references.

## Guidance

The goal of our guidance program is to help prepare students for college with appropriate and successful academic and life experiences. Students receive college/career guidance through the school advisement program. Students are also tested for college placement during their junior year.

Grace Academy has its own Chapter of NHS which is open to selected juniors and seniors who excel in academics, leadership, service and character.

## Sports

We belong to the Mason Dixon Christian Conference. Our sports include girl's volleyball and boy's soccer in the fall, boy's and girl's soccer and boy's baseball in the spring. We compete on the Varsity and Middle school levels.

## Transfer and Home School Credits

Credits are transferred for graduation upon receipt of an official transcript. Credit transfer from home school are reviewed and discussed on a case-by-case basis with the Administration.

  - 2 Credits of Fine Arts
  - 3 Credits Elective
  - 1 Credit SAT Prep

Beginning with the "Class of 2016", students must take at least (1) on-line class for graduation.

## AP Classes and Dual Enrollment

High school students can take a variety of AP classes either on campus, or through our on-line providers.

Juniors and Seniors are eligible to take dual enrollment classes through Hagerstown Community College's ESSENCE Program. This program allows high school students to receive college credit before graduating from high school.
