

The course syllabus for
Bible - 6th Grade

Course Description

In our 6th grade Bible study, students will be introduced to the Old Testament and its general layout. We will look at the primary themes of Genesis through Malachi, following the Bible's own order and layout. We will focus our studies on major events and characters of the Old Testament and knowing where and how to locate those events and characters. We will review the principles of each lesson and gain understanding of applying those biblical principles to everyday life. As students become acquainted with the Bible as a whole, they will grow in confidence in their study and application of God's word.

Enduring Understandings

The student will:

1. Illustrate the doctrine of Creation.
2. Learn skills for interpreting, understanding, and applying the truths of the Bible.
3. Students will demonstrate their knowledge of the attributes of the Godhead.
4. Students will demonstrate their understanding of man and the fall from God and need for a relationship with Christ.

Students will recognize the centrality of Christ by understanding the purpose of His incarnation, life, teachings, death, and resurrection.

Students will be challenged on a regular basis to make a personal faith commitment to Christ as the only way to be reconciled to the Father.

5. Students will be taught to have a concern for others through community service, evangelism, and outreach.

Students will be asked to apply Biblical principles to show a concern for others through community service, evangelism, and outreach.

Students will understand that Christ has commissioned them to go into the entire world, to make disciples, and to serve those in need.

Students will demonstrate Christian character by the way they respond to choices, people, community, evangelism, and outreach.

6. Students will explain a Biblical worldview orally and written against cultural issues.
7. Students will discover what the Bible says about the future of individuals and the world.
