

SYLLABUS

Course Name: Attributes of God
Grade Level: 9th grade
Length: One semester One period per day
Teacher: Mr. Gene Wilson
Required Text: God as He Longs for You to See Him by Chip Ingram Baker Books

Course Description: This course allows students to discover a basic understanding of the existence and nature of God. Students will search the Scriptures for key passages that describe various features about God. These are compared to false beliefs about God in our society. An emphasis is placed on God's presence in daily life.

Course Objectives:

1. Students will evaluate common everyday false beliefs about God.
2. Students will demonstrate their knowledge of the attributes of the Godhead.
3. Students will be challenged to see God in a new light, allowing them to change the way they pray, the way they live, and the way they think about the world around them.
