



# TUITION FEE SCHEDULE

## SCHOOL YEAR 2009-2010

### REGISTRATION DEPOSIT

A non-refundable deposit must be included with your enrollment or re-enrollment application. Effective this year, this deposit will not be applied to your first month's tuition payment.

#### February - July 2009:

- \$100.00 per family with one child
- \$125.00 per family with two children
- \$150.00 per family with three or more children

#### August 1st or later

- Deposit as specified above plus \$75.00 late enrollment fee

### TECHNOLOGY FEE – Due with first month's tuition

\$136.00 per student in grades K5 - 9th or \$100.00 per student in grades 10th - 12th

Tuition payments are spread over an 11-month period. The first payment for school year 2009-2010 is due July 1, 2009, with the final payment due May 1, 2010. Using the chart above, a family with one 3rd grader would pay \$397.00 per month. The due date is the 1st of each month. A 10-day grace period applies before a \$25.00 late fee is charged for each month the payment is past due. Before summer, each family will receive a tuition payment booklet that will specify your particular amounts and can help you keep track of monthly payments. You also have the option of dividing payments over 12 months, starting June 1, 2009. Please notify the office at the time of re-enrollment if you prefer this payment plan.

### DISCOUNTS

Families wishing to pay the 2009-2010 tuition in full by July 1, 2009, receive a 2% discount on the full year's tuition. Full-time pastors receive a 20% discount.

### TUITION ASSISTANCE

We encourage families to consider this option. We utilize a Christian-based, third-party organization to evaluate applications. You may pick up more information in the office.

### DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

Students whose tuition account is two months past due on the 15th school day of the month will not be allowed to attend classes until the account is current or a payment plan is approved by the administrator. Balances must be paid in full by May 31, 2009, in order for re-enrollment to remain in effect for 2009-2010. Students with an outstanding tuition balance at another school will not be permitted to enroll at Grace Academy.

### SAMPLE CALCULATION

For families with more than one child enrolling, be sure to use the correct multiple-child tuition rate from the chart above for the grades in which they are enrolling. For example, the yearly tuition rate for a family of three with children in grades 10th, 6th, and K5, would be calculated as  $\$4,950 + \$3,938 + \$3,817 = \$12,705$ . The monthly payment in this case would be \$1,155.00. In addition, the technology fee would be calculated as  $\$100 + \$136 + \$136 = \$372$ .
